



TERMS & CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

WIN A FAMILY SAILING TRIP TO VANCOUVER

1. Information on how to enter forms part of the terms of entry. Entry into the competition is deemed acceptance of these terms and conditions.
2. Entry is open to all residents of Australia. SA residents must be aged 25 years or over. However, employees and their immediate families of Network TEN, Beinteractive Pty Ltd, and their associated agencies and companies are not eligible to enter.
3. The competition commences on Sunday, 5 September 2010 at 00:01 (AEST) and concludes on Sunday, 19 September 2010 at 23:59 (AEST).
4. The competition will be advertised on Network TEN.
5. To enter, participants must be a registered Ten member and log onto the Ten website www.ten.com.au, click through to the competition and register their contact details on the entry form including (but not limited to) full name, full address including state, daytime phone number, and e-mail address. It is free to become a member however individual internet provider rates may apply.
6. There is a limit of 1 online entry per person per day.
7. Entrants under the age of 18 must obtain the prior permission of a parent or guardian over the age of 18 to enter.
8. Incomprehensible and incomplete entries will be deemed invalid.
9. The Promoter reserves the right to request winners to provide proof of identity, proof of residency at the nominated prize delivery address and/or proof of entry validity (including phone bill) in order to claim a prize. Proof of identification, residency and entry considered suitable for verification is at the discretion of the Promoter. In the event that a winner cannot provide suitable proof, the winner will forfeit the prize in whole and no substitute will be offered.
10. The Promoter reserves the right to verify the validity of entries and to disqualify any entry which, in the opinion of Promoter, includes objectionable content, profanity, potentially insulting, inflammatory or defamatory statements, disqualify any entrant who tampers with the entry process, who submits an entry that is not in accordance with these Terms & Conditions of Entry or who has, in the opinion of Promoter, engaged in conduct in entering the Promotion which is fraudulent, misleading, deceptive or generally damaging to the goodwill or reputation of the Promotion and/or Promoter. The Promoter reserves the right to disqualify a winner if Promoter becomes aware that the winner and/or the winner's entry is of a type described in this clause.
11. Entries must be received by 23:59 (AEST) on Sunday, 19 September 2010. The time of entry will in each case be the time the online entry is received by the Promoter database. The Promoter accepts no responsibility for any late, lost or misdirected entries not received by the Promoter or delays in the delivery of the online entry due to technical disruptions, network congestion or for any other reason.
12. The cost of accessing the promotional website will be dependant on the entrant's individual Internet Service Provider.
13. One major winner will receive a trip for 4 to Vancouver, Canada for two adults and two children up to 18 years including:

- 4 x Return Economy Flights from the winners nearest capital city to Vancouver, Canada
 - 4 x Nights 4 star accommodation in a suite at the Delta Vancouver Suites including breakfast. Suite consists of two double beds plus sofa-bed pullout.
 - Non-exclusive ground transfers to/from the airport and hotel in Vancouver
 - Sailing day and lesson for 4 people, privately chartered with the Deep Cove Yacht Club including return hotel transfers
 - Suspension bridge and lunch excursion including return hotel transfers and lunch up to value of US\$100
 - Basic cover travel insurance
 - US\$200 Spending Money
14. Total prize value is up to = \$10,000 (including GST)
 15. Prizes cannot be transferred, exchanged or redeemed for cash.
 16. The prize is for 2 adults, one being over 25 years of age and the other over 18 years of age, and 2 children both under 18 years of age.
 17. Travel insurance component of the prize is subject to the winner and their companions meeting the insurer's own terms and conditions. If the terms and conditions are not met by an individual then they are responsible for organising their own travel insurance.
 18.  23. A credit card imprint or cash deposit may be required from the winner at check-in to the hotel, for all incidental charges. Once accommodation vouchers are issued they are non-changeable.
 24. It is the traveller's personal responsibility to ensure that they have valid documentation, including but not limited to valid passports with a minimum of 6 months validity from date of travel and visas, which meet the requirements of immigration and other government authorities at every destination. Any fines,

penalties, payments or expenditures incurred as a result of such documents not meeting the requirements of those authorities will be the sole responsibility of the travellers.

25. Network TEN, make no representation as to the safety, conditions or other issues that may exist at any destination. 27. The Promoter shall not be liable for any loss or damage whatsoever which is suffered (including but not limited to indirect or consequential loss) or for any personal injury, sickness or death suffered or sustained in connection with any prize/s except for any liability which cannot be excluded by law. The Promoter is not responsible for any incorrect or inaccurate information, either caused by the phone user or for any of the equipment or programming associated with or utilised in this competition, or for any technical error, or any combination thereof that may occur in the course of the administration of this competition including any omission, interruption, deletion, defect, delay in operation or transmission, communications line or telephone, mobile or satellite network failure, theft or destruction or unauthorised access to or alteration of entries.

The Promoter reserves the right in its sole discretion to disqualify any individual who the Promoter has reason to believe has breached any of these conditions, or engaged in any unlawful or other improper misconduct calculated to jeopardise the fair and proper conduct of the promotion. The Promoter's legal rights to recover damages or other compensation from such an offender are reserved.

Network TEN and their associated agencies and companies assume no responsibility for any error, omission, interruption, deletion, defect, delay in operation or transmission, communications line failure, theft or destruction or unauthorised access to, or alteration of entries, and reserves the right to take any action that may be available.
46. If for any reason this competition is not capable of running as planned, including due to infection by computer virus, bugs, tampering, unauthorised intervention, fraud, technical failures or any causes beyond the control of the Promoter, which corrupt or affect the administration, security, fairness or integrity or proper conduct of this promotion, the Promoter reserves the right in its sole discretion to disqualify any individual who tampers with the entry process, take any action that may be available, and to cancel, terminate, modify or suspend the competition, subject to any written direction given under State Regulation.

information about you to enable you to participate in this promotion but no further use of this information will be made without prior consent.
