



**TERMS & CONDITIONS OF ENTRY
PANASONIC PLAYER OF THE MATCH
AFL COMPETITION**

1. Information on how to enter forms part of the terms of entry. Entry into the competition is deemed acceptance of these terms and conditions.
2. Entry is open to all residents of Australia. However, employees and their immediate families of Network Ten Pty Ltd, Beinteractive Pty Ltd, and their associated agencies and companies are not eligible to enter.
3. Entrants under the age of 18 must obtain the prior permission of a parent or guardian to enter.
4. The competition commences on Saturday 20, March 2010 at 22:00 (AEDT) and concludes on Saturday, 18 September 2010 at 17:00 (AEST). Weekly entry (competition round) commences at 22:00 AEST on dates indicated in CHART A and concludes at 17:00 AEST on the dates indicated in CHART A, except the weekly finals that commence at 15:00 as indicated with an asterisk on CHART A.
5. The draw for the weekly winner x 1 will take place at 12:00 AEDT/AEST as per CHART A commencing Monday, 29 March 2010. If the draw falls on a public holiday, the winner will be drawn the next working day.
6. Participants can enter via the Ten website www.ten.com.au or via the URL www.ten.com.au/afl. Entrants are required to select the name of the person they think is the "Player of the Match" from each AFL round. Users will select one player from a list of names. To be eligible to enter online, participants will be required to be a registered member. Fraudulent memberships/ entries will be deemed invalid. Viewers may register to become a member of Ten via the website. It is free to become a member. To enter, entrants will be required to provide various personal information including name, email address, residential address, contact phone number/s, date of birth and gender for the purpose of verifying eligibility.
7. Incomprehensible and incomplete entries will be deemed invalid. A limit of 1 online entry per entry round applies. Unrecognised or incorrect entries will not be accepted. Entries that do not comply with the format requirement for entry will not be accepted. Online entry is free however internet connection rates may apply.
8. All draws will be conducted at the premises of Beinteractive, Level 9, 155 George Street, Sydney NSW 2000. Judges' decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into. The weekly winner will be drawn from the entrants who correctly guessed the 'AFL Player of the Match' as announced in program by the AFL commentary team. If no entrants have correctly guessed the 'AFL Player of the Match', the weekly prize will be drawn from all entries received during relevant entry period. The winners will be notified within 2 days of the draw and in writing and their details will be published in the public notices section of the Australian on the dates as per CHART A.

The Promoter reserves the right to disqualify a winner if Promoter becomes aware that the winner and/or the winner's entry is of a type described in this clause.

The time of entry will in each case be the time it is received by the Promoter's database and not at the time of submission. The Promoter accepts no responsibility for any late, lost or misdirected entries including entries not received by the Promoter or delays in the delivery of the entry due to technical disruptions, network congestion or for any other reason.
14. The cost of accessing the promotional website will be dependent on the entrant's individual Internet Service Provider.

The Promoter is not responsible for any incorrect or inaccurate information, either caused by the phone user or for any of the equipment or programming associated with or utilised in this competition, or for any technical error, or any combination thereof that may occur in the course of the administration of this competition including any omission, interruption, deletion, defect, delay in operation or transmission, communications line or telephone, mobile or satellite network failure, theft or destruction or unauthorised access to or alteration of entries.

The Promoter reserves the right in its sole discretion to disqualify any individual who the Promoter has reason to believe has breached any of these conditions, or engaged in any unlawful or other improper misconduct calculated to jeopardise the fair and proper conduct of the promotion. The Promoter's legal rights to recover damages or other compensation from such an offender are reserved.
33. Network Ten, Beinteractive and their associated agencies and companies assume no responsibility for any error, omission, interruption, deletion, defect, delay in operation or transmission, communications line failure, theft or destruction or unauthorised access to, or alteration of entries, and reserves the right to take any action that may be available.
34. If for any reason this competition is not capable of running as planned, including due to infection by computer virus, bugs, tampering, unauthorised intervention, fraud, technical failures or any causes beyond the control of the Promoter, which corrupt or affect the administration, security, fairness or integrity or proper conduct of this promotion, the Promoter reserves the right in its sole discretion to disqualify any individual who tampers with the entry process, take any action that may be available, and to cancel, terminate, modify or suspend the competition, subject to any written direction given under State Regulation.
35. All entries become the property of the Promoter. The Promoter collects personal information about you to enable you to participate in this promotion but no further use of this information will be made without prior consent.
36. The Promoter is collecting the entrant's personal information for the purpose of conducting and promoting this competition (including but not limited to determining and notifying winner). The entrant's personal information may be disclosed to Beinteractive for this purpose. If you are not willing for this to occur you cannot participate in the Promotion.
