



TERMS & CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

WONDERS OF THE SPORTING WORLD – HARVEY NORMAN / PANASONIC 2010

1. Information on how to enter forms part of the terms of entry. Entry into the competition is deemed acceptance of these terms and conditions.
2. Entry is open to all residents of Australia who are 18 years of age or over. However, employees and their immediate families of Network TEN, Beinteractive Pty Ltd, Panasonic Australia Pty Ltd, Harvey Norman, and their associated agencies and companies are not eligible to enter.
3. The competition commences on Thursday, 1 July 2010 at 00:01 (AEST) and concludes on Saturday, 31 July 2010 at 23:59 (AEST).
4. The competition will be advertised on Network TEN, One HD and at www.ten.com.au.
5. Participants are required to purchase any Panasonic High Definition Product from participating Harvey Norman, Domayne or Joyce Mayne stores during the month of July, 2010. Each valid purchase will entitle the participant to one entry.
6. To enter, participants must either:
 - a. Log onto www.ten.com.au and register their details; or
 - b. Complete the official entry form found in participating Harvey Norman, Domayne or Joyce Mayne stores with the requested details and submit the entry form in one of the boxes provided in store.

Entrants will be required to register their details (including but not limited to) full name, address, daytime contact number, e-mail address, store number, receipt number (relating to the purchase of each Panasonic HD product), and select which of the 4 prizes they would like to win. Only one prize can be selected per entry form or online registration.

Entrants must retain a copy of their original purchase receipt(s) for all entries as proof of purchase. Failure to provide valid proof of purchase is at the absolute discretion of the Promoter which may result in the invalidation of all of an entrant's entries and forfeiture of any right to a prize.
